CHAPTER 1. GENERAL AUDIT GUIDANCE 1-1.

Audits under the Guide must also be performed in accordance with the standards for financial audits in Government Auditing Standards, issued by the Comptroller General of the United States. The objectives of a HUD program-specific audit under the Guide are to assist the program managers in HUD in determining whether the auditee has: (a) provided financial data and reports that can be relied upon; (b) internal control in place to provide reasonable assurance that it is managing HUD programs ...

Paragraph 1d of part 7 states "If there is an audit guidance issued by the Federal agency's Office of Inspector General (OIG), the auditor may wish to consider this guidance in identifying the program objectives, program procedures, and compliance requirements." CHAPTER *3.* HUD Multifamily Housing Programs 3-1.

Refer to paragraph 1 -7C and chapter 2 for reporting requirements using this audit guide. In cases in which an exception is found, the auditor must determine whether the individual exception is material enough to include or is a compliance violation that must be included in the report.
