On August 31, 2020 Gov. Newsom signed AB 3088, which bans evictions of tenants who can't pay rent due to COVID hardships until February 1, 2021. If the COVID hardship occurs between September 1, 2020 and January 31, 2021, tenants must pay at least 25% of rent due to avoid eviction.

### What the CDC eviction ban means for tenants and landlords ...

The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention issued an order on September 1st (effective September 4th) protecting certain renters from eviction for nonpayment of rent through the end of 2020. The moratorium applies only to renters who meet all of the following criteria:

### Protections for Texas Renters: COVID-19

Evictions in Texas. Texas landlords are empowered to evict tenants for the following reasons: Nonpayment of rent - If a tenant fails to pay rent, then the landlord may issue a 3-Day Notice to Pay or Quit, after any applicable grace period. If the terms of the notice are not met then the landlord may initiate formal eviction proceedings.
